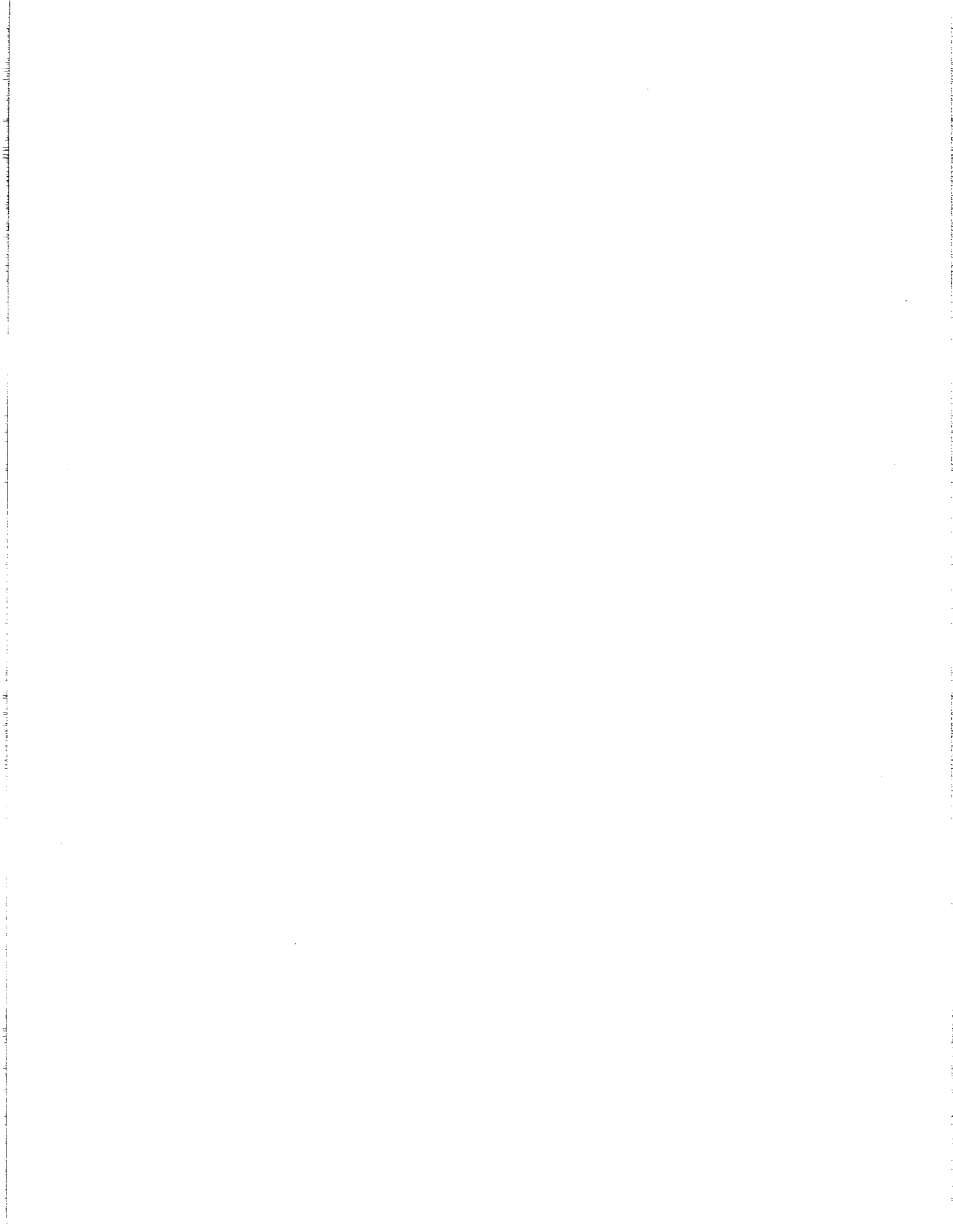

COMPANIES (WINDING-UP) (AMENDMENT)
RULES, 2010

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 302 of the Companies Act, makes the following Rules –

1. **Citation.**

These Rules, which amend the Companies (Winding-up) Rules,¹ may be cited as the Companies (Winding-Up) (Amendment) Rules, 2010.

2. **Amendment of Rule 2 of the principal Rules.**

Rule 2 of the principal Rules is amended by the insertion, in the appropriate alphabetical position, of the following definition –

““company” means a company which is being wound up and includes an international business company.”.

3. **Insertion of a new Schedule into the principal Rules.**

The principal Rules are amended by the insertion, immediately after Rule 101, of the following as a new Schedule –

**“SCHEDULE
COURT FEES**

COMMERCIAL DIVISION

Petitions for the winding-up of Companies \$1,000.00”.
