## MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS ACT (CHAPTER 24)

### PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION (FOREIGN SERVICE ORDERS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023

The Governor-General in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Act (*Ch. 24*) and acting in accordance with the advice of the Public Service Commission hereby makes the following regulations —

#### 1. Citation.

These Regulations, which amend the Public Service Commission (Foreign Service Orders) Regulations, 2014, may be cited as the Public Service Commission (Foreign Service Orders) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023.

#### 2. Insertion of regulation 77A into S. I. No. 98 of 2014.

The principal Regulations are amended by the insertion immediately after regulation 77 of the following new regulation —

##### “77A. Travel on behalf of the Government.

- (1) Any travel by the foreign service on behalf of the Government in accordance with these regulations may be authorized —
  - (a) by Cabinet; or
  - (b) by the Minister in consultation with the Prime Minister.
- (2) The certificate of the Minister shall be conclusive evidence that the travel so authorized is for and on behalf of the Government.

- (3) Any travel expenditure authorized under this section shall be chargeable in the usual manner on the budget of the Foreign Affairs.
