## **BUSINESS LICENCE ACT**

**(NO. 13 OF 2023)**

### **BUSINESS LICENCE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 70 of the Business Licence Act, 2023, makes the following Regulations —

**1. Citation and commencement.**

- (1) These Regulations, which amend the Business Licence Regulations, 2023 (*S. I. No. 49 of 2023*), may be cited as the Business Licence (Amendment) Regulations, 2024.
- (2) The Regulations shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2024.

**2. Amendment of regulation 7 of the principal Regulations.**

Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (1) —

- (a) by the deletion of the words “section 57” and the substitution of the words “section 53”; and
- (b) by the deletion of the words “third column” and the substitution of the words “second column”.

**3. Amendment of the Second Schedule to the principal Regulations.**

The *Second Schedule* to the principal Regulations is amended, by the insertion, immediately after the fees headed “ADMINISTRATIVE FEES”, of the following new subheading, fee entries and corresponding fees —

**“FEE RELATING TO THE FILING OF A COMPLAINT BY A  
LICENSEE AGAINST THE APPROVAL OF A TRADING NAME OF A  
BUSINESS**

On filing a complaint to the Secretary against

the approval of a trading name of a business,  
an inclusive fee of

\$100”.
