**A BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF FURTHER
DIVERS SUMS OF MONEY FOR AND TOWARDS DEFRAYING THE
EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF
THE BAHAMAS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING 1ST
JULY 2023 AND ENDING 30TH JUNE, 2024.**

Enacted by the Parliament of The Bahamas

1. Short title.

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (Capital Development) (2023/2024) Act, 2024.

2. Further expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of The Bahamas.

The further sum of minus ten million five hundred and thirty six thousand, two hundred and four dollars (\$-10,536,204) shall be charged on the Consolidated Fund and other public funds of The Bahamas for the expenses set out in the *Schedule* for the period ending 30th June, 2024.

3. Purpose of appropriation.

The further sum charged by Section 2 of this Act is hereby appropriated to the services and other expenses expressed in the said *Schedule* and shall be deemed to have been appropriated from the 1 July, 2023
