PRISONERS (INVESTMENT OF EARNINGS) RULES

(SECTION 29(7))

[Commencement 21st July, 1966]

Short title.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Prisoners (Investment of Earnings) Rules.

Interpretation.

2. In these Rules —

“Act” means the Prisons Act;

“prescribed” means prescribed by section 29(6) of the Act;

“prisoner” has the meaning assigned to it by section 29(1) of the Act.

“Superintendent” has the meaning assigned to it by section 29(1) of the Act.

Investment of net earnings.

3. (1) Where any prisoner has been engaged in extra-mural employment his net earnings, after deduction of the prescribed amounts from his gross earnings shall be deposited to his credit in an account to be kept for him in the Post Office Savings Bank.

(2) Every such account shall be opened and kept in the name and official title of the Superintendent in trust for the particular prisoner whose name shall be stated in the account and in all records thereof.

Withdrawal of funds.

4. Upon discharge from prison of a prisoner who had been engaged in extra-mural employment, or at such other time or times as may be approved by the Visiting Committee, the Superintendent shall, subject to the requirements of the Post Office Savings Bank, withdraw the amount of principal and interest then standing to the credit of the account of such prisoner and any amount so withdrawn shall be added to the balance of earnings in the hands of the Superintendent and not invested by him prior to discharge of the prisoner on whose behalf such earnings are held.

Form of licence etc.

5. (1) The form of licence to be granted to a prisoner to enable him to engage in extra-mural employment shall be in the Form No. 1 set out in the Schedule to these Rules and such form shall contain therein the conditions of the grant of such licence also set out in the Schedule.

(2) A record of the earnings of the prisoner shall be kept according to Form No. 2 in the Schedule and must be signed by the person by whom the prisoner has been employed.

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

1. This licence may be revoked at any time.
2. The licensee shall remain under the supervision of the Superintendent whilst outside the prison under the terms of this licence.
3. The licensee shall diligently and faithfully work for his employer throughout working hours, and shall return to the prison each day at or at the cessation of his working hours whichever

shall be the earlier, by the most direct route and as speedily as possible.

4. The earnings of the licensee shall be paid to the Superintendent, who shall deduct and pay therefrom such sums as are authorised by section 29(6) of the Prisons Act (Chapter 208). The Superintendent shall from time to time invest the balance of such earnings in the Post Office Savings Bank in trust for the licensee until he is discharged from the prison or until such time or times as may be approved by the Visiting Committee, at which time the sum then standing to the credit of the licensee's Post Office Savings Account will be made available to the licensee in such amount or amounts and at such time or times not later than six months after his discharge as may be approved by the Visiting Committee.
