

IMMIGRATION (OVERTIME) REGULATIONS
(SECTION 45)

S.I. 80/1971

[Commencement 1st September, 1971]

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Overtime) Regulations. Citation.

2. (1) Where the services of any immigration officer are afforded to any person during any time specified in the first column of the Schedule to these Regulations, that person shall pay a charge therefor to the Director of Immigration. Overtime rates.
Schedule.

(2) The charge mentioned in paragraph (1) of this regulation shall, in relation to any such time as aforesaid, be calculated in accordance with the rates respectively specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE (Regulation 2)

	<i>First Column</i>	<i>Second Column</i>
1.	Any Sunday	Twice the hourly rate of pay of the immigration officer
2.	Any public holiday	Twice the hourly rate of pay of the immigration officer
3.	Any night (between) 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.	Twice the hourly rate of pay of the immigration officer
4.	Any Saturday (between) 6 a.m. and 10 p.m.	One and one-half times the hourly rate of pay of the immigration officer
5.	Any other time, being a time before 9 a.m. or after 5.30 p.m.	One and one-half times the hourly rate of pay of the immigration officer
