**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT
(CHAPTER 36)**

**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (EMANCIPATION DAY, 2018) (OPENING OF
SHOPS) NOTICE, 2018**

WHEREAS by section 6 of the Public Holidays Act (“the Act”) it is provided that the Governor-General may, in any special case in which it is expedient to do so, by notice in the *Gazette* authorize the carrying on of business in any shop on any public holiday;

AND WHEREAS the 1st Monday in August is appointed a public holiday under the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Governor-General considers it expedient to authorize the carrying on of business in all shops on Monday, the 6th day of August, 2018, the day celebrated as Emancipation Day in 2018:

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Act, the Governor-General gives the following Notice —

1. Citation.

This Notice may be cited as the Public Holidays (Emancipation Day, 2018) (Opening of Shops) Notice, 2018.

2. Opening of shops on Emancipation Day, 2018.

Business may be carried on in all shops during normal business hours on Monday, the 6th day of August, 2018, the day celebrated as Emancipation Day in 2018.
