**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT  
(CH. 36)**

**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (WHIT MONDAY, 2022)  
(OPENING OF SHOPS) NOTICE, 2022**

**WHEREAS** by section 6 of the Public Holidays Act (the "Act") it is provided that the Governor-General may, in any special case in which it is expedient to do so, by notice in the *Gazette* authorize the carrying on of business in any shop on any public holiday;

**AND WHEREAS** the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday after Whit Sunday has been appointed a public holiday under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2022 is the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday after Whitsunday;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor-General considers it expedient to authorize the carrying on of business in all shops on Monday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2022, the day celebrated as Whit Monday in 2022:

**NOW THEREFORE** in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Act, the Governor-General gives the following Notice —

**1. Citation.**

This Notice may be cited as the Public Holidays (Whit Monday, 2022) (Opening of Shops) Notice, 2022.

**2. Opening of shops on Whit Monday, 2022.**

Business may be carried on in all shops during normal business hours on Monday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2022, the day celebrated as Whit Monday in 2022.
